Cowden Gravel & Ready Mix is acquired by Aggregate Industries, a subsidiary of LafargeHolcim in the United States

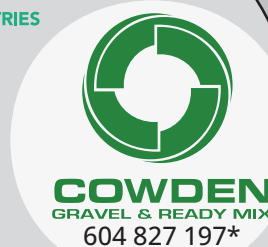
Lafarge owns a cement plant 8.3 miles from the proposed quarry.
